The “online edition” does have a Table of Contents, and it’s full contents “as is” can be scrolled through. But it has no page numbering or other means to determine or effectively control where you are in the document – which makes it extremely difficult to follow in this form.

And it doesn’t appear with the Adobe icon in Upper RH corner – as the papal encyclicals do, which would allow you to download or save it as an Adobe PDF file. So the page numbering which Adobe format provides aren’t available by that means.

Recommendation: if you really want to read it to any extent, **get the book version**. Copies are available “for loan” in the SEAS Adult (Father Kolbe) Library. It’s also possible to purchase copies.
