

COMMUNICATIONS

Church Office And After Hours Help: Help as needed with various duties in the Parish Office. Daytime, evenings and weekends.

Photography Team: Help take pictures of parish events and school activities for use in parish related publications.

Technology Support: Provide Information Technology support to the parish and educational awareness of the risks we face today.

BUILDING & GROUNDS

***Church Cleaning:** First Saturday of every month, typically 1.5 hours. Youth and adult tasks. Leader will delegate cleaning tasks. Last name starting with A-G will clean May, August & November. Last names H-Q clean June September & January. Last names R-Z clean July, October & February.

Groundskeeping: Help with landscaping, mowing and sidewalk snow removal on the parish grounds.

Miscellaneous Skills: Assist with tasks such as carpentry and painting. Minimal time requirement.

Mother Seton Hall Kitchen Cleaning Crew: Light cleaning, straightening and assessing of the kitchen needs. Monday of each week.

Special Parish Events: Assist with setup, teardown or cleanup for special parish wide events.

SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES

Our school community is very appreciative of volunteers and has several opportunities available. Anyone Virtus trained may sign up. You do not need to have a student enrolled to volunteer.

Volunteering is for the 2026 Semester starting January 1, 2026 and the 1st Semester of the following school year starting August of 2027.

***Art:** Volunteers are needed to help with projects and at times assist in material prep such as cutting paper and assembling materials. All projects are pre-planned. Time requirement is about 2 hours a month.

***Athletics Coach:** Assist with coaching various athletic teams during the school year.

***Classroom:** Listen to children read, help with drill and practice activities and independent work.

***Lunchroom:** Help serve and clean up one day a week from 10:40AM-1:10PM.

***Morning Drop-off Supervision:** Monitor the safety of students during morning drop-off one day a week from 7:15AM-7:45AM

***Nurse Office:** Assist on an as needed basis.

***Assist With Screenings:** Assist with dental, hearing, vision and scoliosis screenings.

Provide Teacher Lunches-Conference/Inservice Days: Provide lunches for teachers during Conference and Inservice days.

Mass Supervision: Supervise students at Mass on Wednesday mornings so teachers can attend training.

SCOUTING OPPORTUNITIES

***American Heritage Girls:** Christ-centered scouting program for girls ages 5-18 that embraces Catholic moral standards, personal integrity and good citizenship.

***Cub Scouts:** Assist in developing good character of boys and girls ages 5-11. Encourage youth to be friendly, helpful and to do their best.

***Little Flowers:** A Catholic girls club that teaches virtues through lives of the Saints, Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Ages 5-17.

***Scouts BSA:** Assist in a traditional scouting program for boys aged 11-18. Teach young people about character, citizenship, leadership, outdoor skills and fitness.

SPIRITUAL LIFE & PRAYER

Legion Of Mary: Men, women and youth aid our priests in performing spiritual works for the welfare of souls, in union with Mary.

Perpetual Adoration: Draw closer to God by spending one hour a week with our Lord. The Adoration Chapel is open 24 hours.

Prayer Request E-Group: Email based group that provides prayer support for the needs of our parish.

Rosary Group (In Homes): Pray the Rosary weekly at designated homes. Children welcome.

LITURGY

Greeter/Offertory: Welcome parishioners and guests before Mass and take up the gifts during Offertory.

Lector: Proclaim the Word of God to the congregation.

Liturgical Environment Committee: Assist with Church decorations, floral arrangements and gathering space displays.

***Liturgical Season Decorating:** Help decorate the Church for Christmas and Easter.

***Music Ministry:** Minister to the people gathered by inspiring them through music.

***Nursery (Assist With):** Childcare offered to parishioners during Sunday 9am and 11am Masses and special events. Volunteers must be 8th grade or older.

***Usher:** Assist with seating at weekend and Holy Day Masses.

HUMAN RELATIONS

Baking: Provide parish events with home-baked goods, desserts, muffins, egg bakes, etc., as needed.

***Bierock Making (Sept.):** Prepare and make bierocks for the Fall Bazaar.

Clergy Meals Ministry: A meal service to provide our priests with meals two days a week.

Coffee And Donuts (Fellowship Fridays): Pick up and deliver donuts Friday mornings before the 8am Mass.

***Coffee And Donuts (Sundays):** Serve coffee and donuts after 7:30am and 9am Masses on Sundays.

Compassion Ministry: Support for parishioners experiencing a new birth, loss of a loved one, hospital stay, transportation needs or meal needs. Requires 3 sessions of training. Following training you may select from the following programs: Mother's Group, Bereavement, Hospital Visitations, Transportation or Meals.

HUMAN RELATIONS

Dinner For 8: Groups of 8 adults, single or couples, are formed to meet throughout the year for dinner.

***Fall Bazaar (Oct.):** Annual parish fundraiser to support the care and maintenance of the Church Altar needs. Assist with planning, setup, decorations or clean up.

Funeral Dinners: Provide and/or serve food to alleviate the burden on those grieving.

Kapaun's Men: Kapaun's Men unites men in prayer, formation and discussion in order to help us courageously respond to God's universal call to holiness and become better husbands, fathers, leaders and friends.

***Knights Of Columbus:** For Catholic men 18 and up to promote faith, support clergy and provide fellowship through several events and activities.

Knights Of Columbus/Parish Blood Drive: Volunteer to assist the Red Cross during the Parish Blood Drive.

Ladies Of Mother Seton Activities: An organization of SEAS women of all ages who come together for fellowship, learning and entertainment. Open to all women of the parish.

Meals For Moms With Newborns: Help provide meals to SEAS parishioners that have recently had a new baby. A great way to share some love with the new parents/families and one less thing for them to worry about. We use MealTrain.com to coordinate meal signups, allowing you to pick the meal, date and drop off time.

Men's Basketball: Gives men of the Church the opportunity for fellowship and to play basketball in a welcoming environment.

Moms With Kids With Mixed Abilities: This is a group for moms who have children with mixed abilities. Moms come together once a month, sharing information and friendship for the journey with our children.

***SEASons Senior Luncheon:** Assist with setup/decorating, food prep, serving and clean up. The luncheon provides food, fun and fellowship for our senior parishioners (65 and older). Meets 2nd Saturdays, September through April. Middle School volunteers may serve without a parent.

***Social Parish Events:** Organize social functions to unify and nurture the bond of our parish family.

SoulCore: Fitness that nourishes body and soul through prayer and core strengthening, functional movements.

HUMAN RELATIONS

Spirit Night Committee (Parish Auction): Community building and fundraising event to benefit Catholic education and the parish. Assist with planning, setup, decorations or clean up.

St. Rose Needlecraft Group: Crochet, knit or sew to benefit those in need while enjoying the fellowship of fellow crafters.

Tobias Ministry: Members fulfill the corporal work of mercy-"bury the dead"-by attending the Vigil and/or Funeral Mass to pray for the deceased and to comfort those who are mourning.

Visiting Ministry To Care Facilities: Spend one-on-one time visiting with a nursing home resident or homebound parishioner.

Welcoming Committee: Help assist with brunches for new parishioners twice a year and/or make calls to new parishioners to welcome them to SEAS.

EDUCATION/FORMATION

***Catholic Athletes For Christ:** Sports oriented individuals serving Catholic athletes in the practice of their faith, sharing the Gospel of Christ in and through the unique platform of athletics.

***Jesus' Little Lambs (Sunday School Sept-May, 9-10am):** Assist with a program that provides preschool age children of our parish their first opportunity for religious education in a classroom environment. The goal of this program is to initiate children into Bible study through age-appropriate scripture, crafts and activities.

Natural Family Planning: Teaching safe, effective and morally acceptable forms of family planning. Training provided through the Office of Marriage and Family Life.

***Parish School Of Religion (PSR):** Assist with one hour classes for Wednesday evening religious education for public school students K-12.

OCIA (Order Of Christian Initiation Of Adults): Process whereby men and women are initiated into the Catholic Church. **Team:** Assist with hospitality and sessions.

Sponsors: Attend classes with candidates and catechumens lending support during this process.

***Totus Tuus Assistance:** Assist with a week-long summer Catholic youth program for those in 1st-12th grade.

***Vacation Bible School (VBS):** Assist with a week-long summer celebration of faith for children.

Walking With Purpose Women's Bible Study: Participate in a Bible study which leads women of all ages, faith and marital status to Christ through the community of a small group.

YOUTH MINISTRY

***AXIOS High School Youth (Assist with):** Meets every Tuesday, 7:30pm-9:00pm. Speaker Presentation, Service Night, Adoration Night and Games/Recreation Night are scheduled monthly. Evening closes with night prayer in the Two Hearts Chapel.

PEACE & SOCIAL JUSTICE

Committee On Catholic Social Doctrine: Review and discuss current societal problems to consider how applying Catholic Social Doctrine could improve conditions for God's people, work to improve their situations by action as well as charity, and thus help increase appreciation for God's gifts to us.

Embrace Grace: Help, inspire and equip the church to love and encourage single pregnant women and their families. Women experiencing unexpected pregnancies receive spiritual and emotional support and a big baby shower thrown by our parishioners.

Feed My Starving Children MobilePack: As a Christian nonprofit, FMSC MobilePack is dedicated to seeing every child whole in body and spirit. FMSC MobilePack meals are hand packed by volunteers for the malnourished in nearly 70 countries.

Guadalupe Clinic: Guadalupe Clinic needs medical and nursing volunteers to offer their time and talent. The clinic is a donation-based safety net clinic giving compassionate, quality healthcare to adults aged 18 years and older. Patients have no health insurance and are the underserved and poor in our community. We rely on volunteer physicians, specialists, nurses, mid-level providers, optometrists, pharmacists and other licensed health care providers. Do you have an active or exempt license and 3 hours per month to serve? We can provide liability cover.

Lord's Diner: Hot meals served to those in need 365 days a year. SEAS Parish monthly commitment is the 4th Wednesday and 4th Sunday.

Meals On Wheels: Weekend delivery of meals to homebound every 4-5 months.

Respect Life Ministry: Work for the sanctity of human life.

SEAS St. Anthony Family Shelter: Help provide a Sunday night meal to the Shelter - 3rd Sunday of the month throughout the year.

St. Helena's Helping Hands: Help provide necessary household items and clothing for the less fortunate who are starting over due to traumatic family situations.

St. Vincent de Paul Mission Ministry: Help the poor in their time of need.
