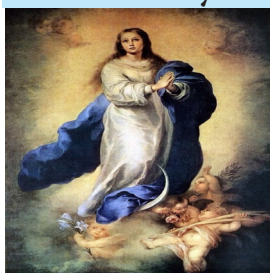

Regrettably summer is coming to an end and we here in the parish office haven't had much time to relax. It has been very busy, with weddings and frankly, too many funerals. But I want to catch everyone up on what is going on.

We have a new facility manager, Todd, who has been thrown into the fire. First, we discovered pin hole leaks in the HVAC plumbing. We are not sure of the full extent but we could be looking at a serious rework of the HVAC system.

Second, as you may have guessed the Church roof and the Rectory roof have been totaled. We are not sure exactly when work will begin. The school's flat roof has some damage but not nearly as extensive.

We have begun discussions about widening the north exit out of the main parking lot. We would add a right hand turning bay. That might be on hold until we get figures on the HVAC plumbing. Also with the new playground we had to do work on drainage and sprinklers that is still ongoing.

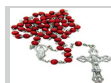
